EVERYONE involved with the caregiving situation/families must be, open, interested and want to participate, this includes the care recipient. Any minor youth caregivers, would need permission by their parents/guardians.

What will filming be like?

This will be an INDEPENDENT documentary. There isn't a big budget so there will not be big movie, crews, glitz, glamour etc.
